On Snow Performance Outcomes

The following performance outcomes will be completed through skill demonstrations:

- Demonstrate/verify the fundamental skiing/riding abilities and tasks that are necessary for patrolling on varying terrain/snow conditions progressing from easier to more difficult. (without a toboggan)
- Describe components and functions of various toboggans in order to enable a toboggan check prior to use.
- Demonstrate ability to safely use On Snow and First Aid equipment at home area.
- Demonstrate safety, control and competency with an empty toboggan on varying terrain/snow conditions progressing from easier to more difficult.
- Demonstrate safety, control and competency with a loaded toboggan on varying terrain/snow conditions progressing from easier to more difficult.
- Demonstrate competency with a two-person toboggan by providing for a safe, smooth, and controlled descent in a variety of terrain/snow conditions while in the front/drag position or exchanging positions.
- Demonstrate a safe approach to an incident site with an unloaded toboggan including: approach, scene survey, properly securing the toboggan, organizing and controlling the scene, patient assessment and loading, communicating.
- Demonstrates knowledge of home area policies, procedures and communication.
- Demonstrate safety, control and competency while performing a simulation that includes: being called to an incident, getting and inspecting a toboggan, bringing an unloaded toboggan to an incident site, securing a toboggan, basic incident site management, loading a patient, and running a loaded toboggan.
